Upon concurrence and approval by the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, the SKED bereby agrees to purches the proposed site for the sum of \$5.40,000.00 (the-hundred forty thousand dollars). This sum includes the purchase price of the property, \$500,000, and \$40,000 (forty-thousand dollars) to reimburne the Foundation for clearing the property to men the conditions set forth by the Fish and Wildliffs Service in a letter dated Jassasy 21, 2003. A copy of the contract to clear the proposed Intermodal Park site should be included with the above materials.

In accordance with the Resolution adopted May 5, 2004 by the Somerast Pulsait County Development Foundation, Inc., enclosed herein, the Foundation that provide to SKED is required \$500,000 (five-hundred thousand) Development Grant (h) on or before the date SKED fromally acquires the proposed Intermodal Park sinc. Further, the Foundation shall remit to SKED on or before December 31, 2005, a \$100,000 (one-hundred thousand) grant (c), the first of five payments, in further the Park's overall development.

Once the property acquisition phase has been completed, SKED will immediately hegin the fina design and construction phase. The construction phase is expected to take approximately fifteen months to complete.

NOW THEREFORE, upon completion of the reconstructed Ky. 1577/Ky. 1247, the City of Somerset agrees to accept the assignment and conveyance of

Old South Richardson Drive - From the Junction of the reconstructed Ky. 2303 - South Richardson Drive Rt. Approx. Sta. 71+85, extending East, a distance of approximately 0.03 miles (See Exhibits B-2 & B-3).

Old South Main Street - From the Junction of the Jecksboro Street antending north and west, a distance of approximately 0.08 miles (Set Exhibit 8-6).

Jacksboro Street - From the Junction with reconstructed Ky, 2302 extending south to the intersection with Sherman Avenue, a distance o approximately 0.474 miles (See Exhibit B-7).

ADDITIONALLY THEREFORE, upon completion of the reconstructed Ky 1577Ky, 1247, the City of Someraet also agrees to re-society ownership and maintain or cause to maintain the following facilities:
