

MINUTES OF MEETING HELD JUNE 12, 2006

The Common Council of the City of Somerset, Kentucky met in regular session on Monday, June 12, 2006 at 7:00 p.m. with the following present: Mayor JP Wiles. City Attorney Joe Travis and City Clerk David Godsey. Absent: Council Member Joann Norfleet.

Mayor Wiles acknowledged that Friday June 16, 2006 was the city employee's blood drive and those who participate will receive ½ day off with pay.

Mr. Wheeldon moved to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting held on May 22, 2006 and the reports be approved as delivered. Mr. Beasley seconded the motion. 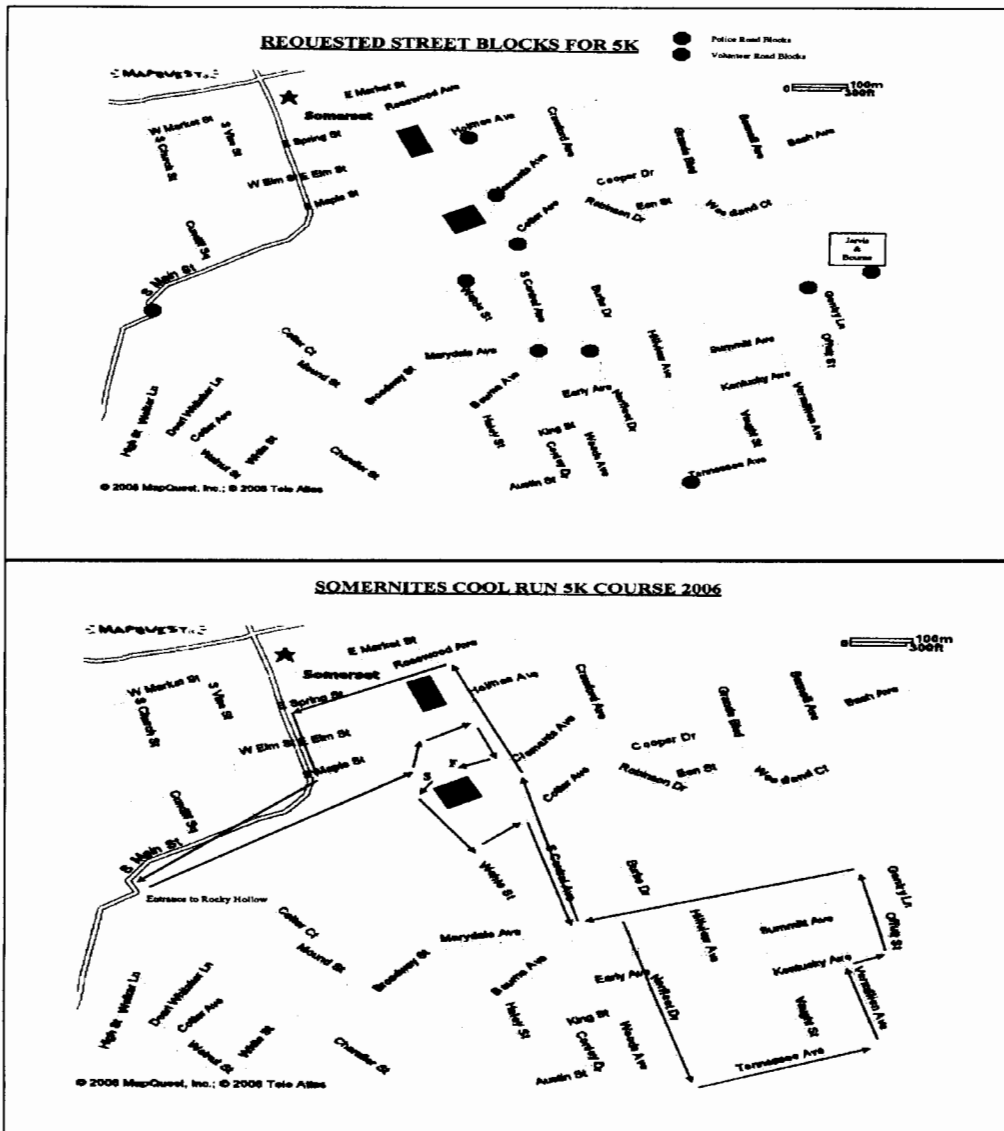
Dear Council Members,

On June 24, 2006 we have scheduled the 9th Annual Somernites Cruise Cool Run 5K Run/Walk. For 6 years this race operated under the exclusive name of the Cool Run and quickly established itself as one of the fastest growing 5K events in the state of Kentucky. Beginning with the June 2004 race, the Cool Run developed a new partnership with one of the most exciting and rapidly growing community events in south central Kentucky, the Somernites Cruise.

Last year we had a record number of race participants and it has been predicted that our event will one day be one of the largest 5K events held in our state. Each year since it's beginning a large portion of the Cool Run proceeds have been donated to the three local high school track and cross country programs and the Kevin Crowe Scholarship Fund.

We would like to request the City's permission to block several intersections along the race course. We would also like to request help from the Somerset Police Department in blocking three intersections on the race course to protect our participants from traffic. You will find attached a map of the race course and another map showing where we would like permission to block intersections.

The actual race is scheduled to begin at 7:00 p.m. and will start and finish at Rocky Hollow Park. The total time required for all entrants to complete the course is usually just under one hour. As stated above this race is a "Run/Walk". The "runners" complete the entire race in approximately 30 minutes and run in the streets. The "walkers" complete the entire race in approximately 55 minutes and after the start generally use the sidewalks. The first 30 minutes of the race are the most critical in maintaining safety for the participants as these individuals are in the streets and running at speed.



LEASE AGREEMENT

This lease agreement made this the 9th day of June, 2006 by and between the City of Somerset, Kentucky, "Lessor", and Cumberland Lake Shell, Inc., of 150 Railroad Drive, Somerset, KY 42501, "Lessee".

The lessor in consideration of the mutual promises and agreements hereinafter set out, do hereby lease, let and demise unto the lessee a portion of land for a billboard structure. This billboard is currently erected and is located on North Hwy 27 at the City of Somerset's Somersplash Waterpark.

The terms of this lease are as follows:

1. The term of this lease shall be 99 years from the signing of this agreement.
2. The consideration for the term of this lease shall be \$1.00 (One Dollar) and is due at the signing of this agreement.
3. Cumberland Lake Shell, Inc. is responsible for repair and maintenance of the billboard. Cumberland Lake Shell, Inc. will provide liability insurance.
4. Lessor agrees to give an access way for Lessee to get to the billboard structure.
5. This lease is contingent on approval of the KY State Highway Department.
