NOTICE OF VETO

August 1, 2007

I, Eddie Girdler, Mayor of the City of Somerset, do hereby veto Ordinance # 07-09 for the following reason(s):

1. The allocation of \$40,000 for investigative work is a potential waste of tax payer dollars that should be spent on our citizens who are needing every dime to pay bills every month.
2. The Budget already provides for the legitimate needs of the City Council as pertaining to needs in carrying out their official duties so the extra \$40,000 appears to be unrelated to legitimate and identified needs and may be inconsistent with the Fund Balance Budget process.
3. All expenditures for council employee must be consistent with KRS.
4. The action may result in a total cost of \$100,000 since any Council action relating this type of issue brings a subsequent action by the Executive branch.

ORDINANCE NO. 02-09

AN ORDINANCE TO THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY, ALLOCATING FUNDS IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2007-2008, SAID FUNDS TO BE USED BY THE CITY COUNCIL IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THEIR OFFICIAL DUTIES,

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY HEREBY ORDAIN AND STATE:


- (A) The Council, through this official legislative act relating to the internal operation and function of the City, wishes to have funds allocated in the 2007-2008 Fiscal Budget of the City, for the use of the Council in carrying out their official duties under the law; and
- (B) The Council wishes that funds in the amount of \$40,000.00 be allocated for this purpose, and that said allocation is to be made within the General Fund as set forth in the 2007-2008 Fiscal Budget of the City, specifically from the Executive Department's expenditures;
- (C) This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon two readings, adoption by the Somerset City Council, and publication according to law.
