




MINUTES OF MEETING HELD NOVEMBER 13, 2006


The Common Council of the City of Somerset, Kentucky met in regular session on Monday, November 13, 2006 at 7:00 p.m. with the following present: Mayor JP Wiles. Council Members: Jerry Burnett, Tim Rutherford, Clarence Floyd, Mark Beasley, Jerry Girdler, Charlie New, Donna Hunley, John Minton, Jim Mitchell and Fonda Crawford. Deputy City Clerk Janet Wilson and City Attorney Joe Travis. Absent: Council Members Joann Norfleet and Jerry Wheeldon.

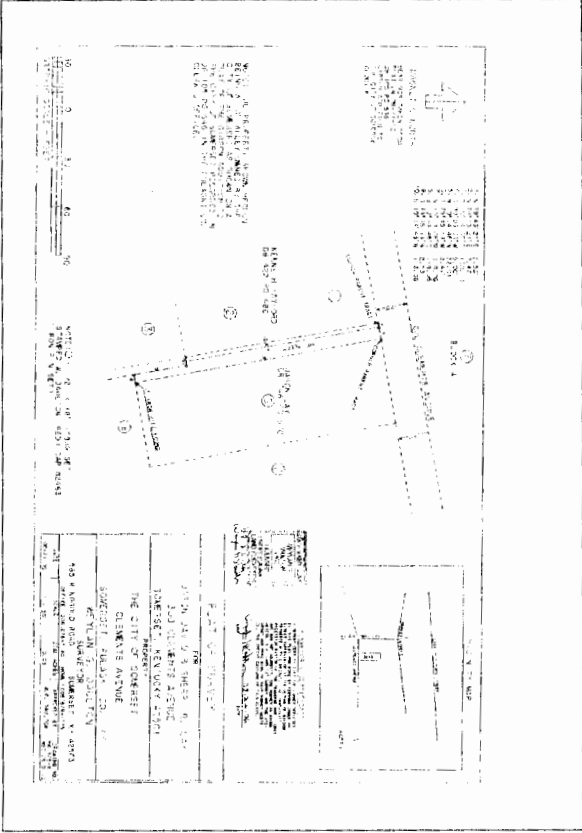
Mrs. Crawford moved to approve the request of Water Park Manager FaithAnne Molyneaux request to set the 2007 summer pass prices and to adjust park policies regarding the tube slide height requirements and the low attendance policy. Mr. Beasley seconded the motion. Upon roll call the following Council Members voted “Aye”: Mr. Burnett, Mr. Rutherford, Mr. Beasley, Mr. Girdler, Mr. New, Mrs. Hunley, Mr. Minton, Mr. Mitchell and Mrs. Crawford. Voting “Nay”: Mr. Floyd.

<div></div> <div><p><u>Proposals:</u> Adjust Summer 2007 Summer Pass Price to: \$49.95 December 1 - May 25 (from \$39.95) \$69.95 May 26 - September 3 (from \$59.95)</p><p><u>Explanation:</u> Summer Passes will be offered at a \$20 discount per pass prior to opening day. Opening Day for Summer 2007 is May 26. We are starting the pass sale in December in order for our guests to purchase Summer 2007 passes as holiday gifts.</p><p>The base summer pass price has increased \$10 per pass from the Summer 2006 rate. This increase is a reflection of the current \$2.1 million addition currently underway - The Giant Wave Pool.</p><p>SomerSplash will continue to offer a discount to families for multiple pass purchases. For every 3 passes purchased, \$10 will be deducted from the total. Passes can be purchased either at SomerSplash, over the phone or by mail.</p><p>SomerSplash will accept cash, check, money order, Visa & MasterCard. All information is available online at www.SomerSplash.com.</p><p>Every person purchasing a Summer 2007 will receive a copy of the SomerSplash park policies.</p><p>Children under age 2 are not required to purchase a pass.</p><p>Local sales tax will be added to all pass purchases.</p><p>SomerSplash will once again offer a payment plan option for those who wish to make payments on their passes. Payments must be completed by May 1, 2007.</p></div>	<div></div> <div><p><u>Proposals:</u> Adjust Park Policy: Tube Slide</p><p><u>Current Description:</u> Full Splash \$12.95 - For our guests under 48 inches tall or those not wishing to ride the large outdoor slides. Allows for entry at Kiddie Play and The Lazy River. Must be at least 48 inches tall to ride Lazy River Slide.</p><p>Body Slides \$14.95 - For our guests at least 48 inches tall wishing to ride the large outdoor slides. Allows for entry at Kiddie Play and The Lazy River as well.</p><p><u>Proposed Descriptions:</u> Catch A Wave \$12.95 - For our guests under 48 inches tall or those not wishing to ride the large slides. Allows for entry at Kiddie Play, The Lazy River and The Wave Pool. Catch A Wave's are not permitted to ride the large slides.</p><p>Body & Slides \$14.95 - For our guests at least 48 inches tall, who wish to ride the large slides. "Body & Slides" includes everything in the park! Body Slides, Tube Slide, Lazy River, Kiddie Play and The Wave Pool. No guest under 48 inches tall may purchase this admission.</p><p><u>Explanation:</u> Prior to opening day, we were informed that there was not a height requirement attached to the tube slide. Upon meeting with a representative from Splashatular, the manufacturer of the slide, we learned the contractor had made a mistake - each rider must be at least 48 inches tall to ride all slides.</p><p>Policy currently states guests who have purchased the non slide admission and are at least 48 inches tall may ride the tube slide, because it is attached to the Lazy River.</p><p>Policy will be revised to reflect that only those who have purchased the "Body & Slides" admission may ride any of the large slides. This will alleviate confusion for both staff and guests.</p></div>
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<div></div> <div><p><u>Proposals:</u> Adjust Park Policy - Low Attendance</p><p><u>New Policy:</u> SomerSplash management reserves the right to close the Waterpark facility due to low attendance, when there are less than 100 guests in the park. Guest attendance will not be evaluated until at least 3:00 P.M.</p><p><u>Explanation:</u> Currently the policy states that if there are less than 20 people in the park at least an hour prior to closing, management can close the park.</p><p>For Summer 2006, our daily average attendance was 581 people, with the high at 1223 (low of 31). We were required to stay open based on our current policy with only 31 people in the park.</p><p>For our lowest attendance day, 27 of the 31 people were passholders - the remaining 5 people in the park purchased a "Dockadee" or day admission.</p></div>

The Department shall be responsible for providing Municipal Road Aid Discretionary Bond funding in an amount not to exceed \$233,000 for the above-mentioned Project.</p> <p>2. 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AGREEMENT BETWEEN KYTC AND CITY OF SOMERSET. PERFORM BITUMINOUS RESTRAFCING ON

3 The City shall cause the Project to be constructed to a level which meets applicable city street and bridge standards (all bridges will be required to meet or exceed an HS-25 loading); and all materials paid for by the Department used on, or incorporated into, the Project shall meet the requirements specified in the Highway Department's Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction. Edition of 2004 State Specifications. The City will obtain any required permits or approval of plans for work to be accomplished on state-owned right-of-way from the Cabinet's District 8 Office in Somerset, KY. The City hereby agrees to put forth a reasonable effort to do maintenance on roads listed herein prior to Bituminous surface being applied. Maintenance being defined but not limited to proper ditching, cleaning or replacement of clogged or deficient drain files, proper shouldering, and any other obvious maintenance the road may need. On bituminous initial treatment projects, the road shall be prepared and shaped to allow for proper runoff of water and for a uniform surface thickness.

4. The City shall indemnify and hold harmless the Department and all of its officers, agents, and employees from all suits, actions, or claims of any character because of any injuries or damages received by any person, persons, or property resulting from construction of the Project.

5. The Department shall reimburse the City up to \$233,000 for completion of work by the City under the obligations of this Agreement for the Project. If the actual cost of the project is less than \$233,000 the excess funds shall be credited back to the Municipal Road Aid Discretionary Bond Fund.

5 Any other costs necessary to accomplish the work for the Project shall be borne by the City, however the City shall not be required to expend any more than \$233,000, which represents the total obligation of the Department.

7. The City shall maintain for a period of three (3) years, all records, of material, equipment, and labor costs involved in the performance of the work for the Project. In order to obtain reimbursement from the Department for the Project, the City shall submit to the Office of Rural and Secondary Roads documented invoices of materials, equipment, and labor used on the Project, including certification that the work was accomplished on a publicly maintained facility.

8. The City may submit current billings reflecting the actual cost of the project during any given work period. This bill should indicate if it is for partial payment or final payment. The current billings will be paid within a reasonable time after receipt of same by the Department; however, in no event is the City to submit billings for work performed for less than a thirty-day (30) period.

9. The Department reserves the right to inspect the methods used in order to perform the work necessary to successfully complete the Project and also reserves the right to cease all work commenced under the terms of this agreement at any time.

10. The City will pass the attached Resolution and a copy of that resolution shall be attached to and made a part of this Agreement.
