
Attorney Bruce Orwin was present as legal council.

RESOLUTION AND AGREEMENT CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY

A RESOLUTION AND AGREEMENT OF THE COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY, TO ENTER INTO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE "SOMERSET CENETERY". A PRIVATE NON-PROFIT ENTITY FOUND WITHIN THE INCOPPORATED BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET, IN ORDER TO LIELP MAINTAIN THE GROUNDS, MAKE REASONABLE REPAIRS, AND PRESERVE THE HISTORICAL VALUE AND INTEREST OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET CEMETARY.

WHEREAS, the City of Somerset, Kentucky, by and through the City Council, bas agreed with the Somerset Centerty Governing Board that it shall provide routine maintenance to the grounds of the property known as "Someraet Centetery", whose main entrance is located on Columbia Street within the corporate boundaries of the City of Someraet; that the City and provide reasonable and minor repairs when and where needed on said property in order to keep said property open to the public and safe for the henefit and enjoyment of the citizens of this community; and that the city shall provide assistance in preserving the historical aspects of said property for present and future engerations of the City of Something.

WHEREAS, it is recognized that the City and the City Council of Somerset has the suthority to spend public funds on such property and for the benefit of a non-profit organization such as the one at hand in order to preserve the history and maintain the property for the safety and benefit of all citizens of the City of Somerset and of Pulaski County, both present and future.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved and ordained by the Common Council of the City of


- That the City hereby states that it shall provide support in the form of


