## RESOLUTION Midtown Sanitary Sewer Upgrades City of Somerset, Kentucky March 14, 2011

The Somerset City Council authorizes a grant application to be submitted to the US Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration (EDA). The purpose of the grant is to make improvements to the City's sewerage collection and transportation systems. These improvements are known as the "Midtown Sanitary Sewer Upgrades", which will replace aging and undersized trunk sewers. The City will request approximately \$1,800,000 in EDA funds. The City will provide local matching funds of approximately \$1,200,000. Final amounts of the grant application and matching funds will be determined once that final cost estimates are completed on the proposed project. These funds will be from available city reserve funds or from a loan. The Mayor is authorized to sign documents relating to the submittal of the grant application to EDA, including the application forms and necessary assurances. The Mayor is authorized to commit the City's matching funds for the project. If the grant application is approved by EDA the Mayor is authorized to sign the grant acceptance from EDA.
