
## MINUTES OF MEETING HELD JULY 26, 2004


Mayor Wiles recognized Becky Edwards from the Leadership Group at Meece Middle School.

Central Kentucky Blood Center recognized the 28 City of Somerset volunteer donors who participated in the recent blood drive.



## ORDINANCE NO. 04-08

## AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO A TELEPHONE AND COMMUCICATIONS FRANCHISE
