

Second reading was given the following Ordinance:

ORDINANCE NO. 05-09
AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A BANK FRANCHISR AND LOCAL DEPOSIT TAX: SETTING FORTH TIME TABLES FOR THE COLLECTION OF SUCH TAX FOR THE YEAR 2004 AND ALL SUBSEQUENT YEARS: AND SETTING FORTH EMPORCEMENT PROCEDURES, INCLUDING FEMALTIES FOR THE COLLECTION OF BELLINGUEST TAXES.
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:
SECTION 1: There is hereby imposed on sil "financial institutions" as defined in KRS. Chapter 136, located within the corporate limits of the City of Somernet, Kestucky, for the 2005 tax year and all subsupent years, a Franchice tax at the rate of 0.025% on sil deposits, as defined in KRS Chapter 136, maintained by such financial institutions.
SECTION 2: The City of Somerset, Kentucky will issue tax bills to financial institutions no later than December I of each year. Psyment of the tax shall be due with a two percent (28) discount by December 31 of each year, or wishout discount by January 31 of each year.
SECTION 3: The City of Somerset, Kentucky, shall have a lien for taxes on the property assessed for taxes to the extent allowed under KRS 134-420.
SECTION 4: All taxes due in accordance with these actions which are not paid before June 20, 2006 for the tax, year 2005, or which are not paid before January 31, for all abbequent tax, years shall be detended delimpuent and shall be subject to a penalty of .20% and shall bear interest at the rare of 6% per anneur.
SECTION 5: All moneye collected pursuant to these sections shall be paid into the General Fund of the City to be used for the payment of proper expenditures as determined by the City Council.
SECTION 6: The City Clerk is hereby directed to send a copy of their Ordinance to the Commissioner of the Kentucky Department of Revenue, Prankfort, Kentucky.
