The Common Council of the City of Somerset, Kentucky met in a special called meeting on Monday August 6, 2012, at 5:30 p.m. with the following present: Mayor Eddie Girdler. Second reading was given the following Ordinance # 12-09:

ORDINANCE NUMBER 12-09

AN ORDINANCE TO THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY, ADOPTING IN THE FOLLOWING SET OF REGULATIONS AND REQUIRMENTS FOR ALCOHOL BEVERAGE CONTROL, HERINAFTER TO BE KNOWN AS THE CITY OF SOMERSET’S “**ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL ORDINANCE**”; AND FURTHER ADOPTING ALL APPLICABLE AND REQUIRED KRS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, KRS CHAPTERS 241 THROUGH 244; AND

WHEREAS, THE CITY OF SOMERSET, BY AND THROUGH A MAJORITY OF REGISTERED VOTERS, NOW PERMITS THE PRESENCE OF ALCOHOL, MANUFACTURING, AND SALES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET SO LONG AS SUCH IS DONE IN ACCORDANCE WITH ALL APPLICABLE LOCAL, STATE, AND FEDERAL LAW; AND

WHEREAS, THE CITY OF SOMERSET THEREFORE MUST ESTABLISH UNIFORM REGULATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR THE LICENSING AND REGULATION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, MANUFACTURE, AND SALES PURSUANT TO AUTHORIZATION UNDER KRS CHAPTERS 241 THROUGH 244;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY, THAT THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS ARE HEREBY ADOPTED AS SET FORTH BELOW:

Mr. Bourne moved to approve the above Ordinance # 12-09 on its second reading adopting the Alcohol Beverage Control Ordinance. Mr. Mitchell seconded the motion.
