



Mr. New made a motion to enter into an agreement with KY State Department of Education for a pilot study for school busses to run on CNG (Compressed Natural Gas). Two busses will be purchached by the KY Department of Education. One bus going to Somerset and one bus going to Pulaski County. The City of Somerset will convert each bus to natural gas at a cost of \$50K per bus. The natural gas will then be sold by the City of Somerset. Mr. Bourne seconded the motion.
