
MINUTES OF MEETING HELD FEBRUARY 27, 2012

The Common Council of the City of Somerset, Kentucky met in a regular session on Monday, February 27, 2012 at 7:00 p.m. with the following present: Mayor Eddie Girdler. Mr. Mitchell moved to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held on February 13, 2012 along with the reports as mailed. Mr. Minton seconded the motion. Mr. Mitchell moved to approve the renewal of the existing contract for solid waste disposal with Scott Solid Waste Disposal Company, Inc. for additional five (5) year period at a transport and disposal rate of twenty eight dollars and seventy five cents (\$28.75) per ton and to approve amendment one to the Solid Waste Disposal and Transportation agreement dated March 15, 2007 that allows the delivery of solid waste to the G & W transfer station for handling and transport for a rate of six dollars and twenty five cents (\$6.25) per ton. Mr. Burnett seconded the motion.
