BATTERIES:

- Lead acid batteries
- Drv cell
- Lithium
- Ni-Cad
- Recyclable

OXIDIZERS:

- Pool chemicals
- Spa chemicals
- Bleaches
- Hydrogen peroxide
- Ammonium nitrate fertilizer

MERCURY:

- Free liquid
- Thermostats
- Thermometers
- Any device containing mercury
- Mercurochrome

CORROSIVES:

- Drain cleaners
- Toilet bowl cleaners
- Muriatic acid
- Deck wash
- Vinegar
- Stop bath
- Acetic acid
- Lye

REACTIVES:

- Aluminum paint
- Flammable solids
- · Dangerous-when-wet materials

PAINT:

- Oil based
- Latex

PROPANE:

(Must be manufacturer labeled as propane)

- 20# Gas grill type
- 1# Soldering/Small stove type
- Larger propane tanks (on a case by case basis)

FLUORESCENT BULBS:

- 4' and 8' Bulbs (unbroken)
- Compact fluorescent lamps (CFL)

PCB MATERIALS (Polychlorinated Biphenyis):

- Light ballasts
- Capacitors
- Free-liquid oils (must be marked as such)

AEROSOL CANS: Any and all types

MOTOR OIL: All types, EXCEPT PCB oils

SOLVENTS: All compatible flammable solvents, such as: gasoline, kerosene, lamp fluid, automotive fluids, etc.

PESTICIDES/HERBICIDES/INSECTICIDES: All liquid and solid forms, such as law fertilizers, lawn foods, lawn treatments, plant foods, insecticides, rodent poisons/killers, etc.
