

MINUTES OF MEETING HELD JULY 23, 2012

The Common Council of the City of Somerset, Kentucky met in a regular session on Monday, July 23, 2012 at 7:00 p.m. with the following present: Mayor Eddie Girdler. Mr. Wheeldon moved to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held on July 9, 2012, along with the reports as mailed. Mr. Eastham seconded the motion. First reading was given the following Ordinance # 12-09:

ORDINANCE NUMBER 12-09

AN ORDINANCE TO THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY, ADOPTING IN THE FOLLOWING SET OF REGULATIONS AND REQUIRMENTS FOR ALCOHOL BEVERAGE CONTROL, HERINAFTER TO BE KNOWN AS THE CITY OF SOMERSET'S **"ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL ORDINANCE"**; AND FURTHER ADOPTING ALL APPLICABLE AND REQUIRED KRS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, KRS CHAPTERS 241 THROUGH 244; AND

WHEREAS, THE CITY OF SOMERSET, BY AND THROUGH A MAJORITY OF REGISTERED VOTERS, NOW PERMITS THE PRESENCE OF ALCOHOL, MANUFACTURING, AND SALES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET SO LONG AS SUCH IS DONE IN ACCORDANCE WITH ALL APPLICABLE LOCAL, STATE, AND FEDERAL LAW; AND

WHEREAS, THE CITY OF SOMERSET THEREFORE MUST ESTABLISH UNIFORM REGULATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR THE LICENSING AND REGULATION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, MANUFACTURE, AND SALES PURSUANT TO AUTHORIZATION UNDER KRS CHAPTERS 241 THROUGH 244;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY, THAT THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS ARE HEREBY ADOPTED AS SET FORTH BELOW:


Mr. Rutherford moved to approve the following Resolution # 12-09 authorizing the purchase of property on Hail Knob Road from the Housing Authority in the amount of \$125,000. Mr. Burnett seconded the motion. RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Somerset is in the process of determining the need for an new facility for the provision of emergency medical services (EMS) or other property needs of the city; and


WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of Somerset Board of Commissioners has authorized that the first priority for sale of surplus property on Hail Knob Road between the Housing Authority office and Greystone Manor be given to the City of Somerset prior to public auction; and


WHEREAS, the Housing Authority has offered to sale the property to the City at cost of previous improvements; and

WHEREAS, a committee of the City Council has met at the site and determined the site's suitability for a future EMS facility or other city facility needs.

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council hereby authorizes the purchase of the Hail Knob Road property from the Housing Authority for \$125,000 with \$62,500 of the purchase price being applied to the Housing Authority and \$62,500 being applied to the Somerset Home Ownership Commission for investment in affordable housing in the City of Somerset.
