Second reading was given the following Ordinance # 10-06:

ORDINANCE NUMBER 10-06

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE REVISED CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY PAY & CLASSIFICATION PLAN WHICH SHALL BE EFFECTIVE RETROACTIVELY TO THE BEGINNING OF THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2010 AND SHALL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL SUCH TIME AS THE PLAN IS REVIEWED AND/OR AMENDED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL;

WHEREAS, KRS 83A.070(4) REQUIRES THAT EACH CITY SHALL FIX THE COMPENSATION OF CITY EMPLOYEES IN ACCORDANCE WITH A PERSONNEL AND PAY CLASSIFICATION PLAN, WHICH PLAN SHALL BE ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE AND REVIEWED EACH YEAR ALONG WITH THE BUDGET;

WHEREAS, A PAY AND CLASSIFICATION PLAN HAS BEEN PREPARED/UPDATED AND DELIVERED TO THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY; AND

WHEREAS, THE COMMON COUNCIL HAS REVIEWED THE REVISED PAY AND CLASSIFICATION PLAN AND HAS APPROVED CHANGES AS THEY APPEAR ON THE PLAN ATTACHED HERETO AS EXHIBIT "A",

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY:

SECTION 1. THERE IS HEREBY ADOPTED A PAY AND CLASSIFICATION PLAN ATTACHED HERETO AS EXHIBIT "A", AND MADE PART HEREOF, AND INCORPORATED IN FULL, SAID PLAN HEREBY ESTABLISHING AUTHORIZED POSITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT WITH THE CITY, EACH POSITION HAVING A CORRESPONDING RANGE OF COMPENSATION AS SET FORTH IN SAID DOCUMENT.

SECTION 2. THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND SHALL BE APPLIED RETROACTIVELY AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND UPON PUBLICATION ACCORDING TO LAW.

## RESOLUTION 10

A RESOLUTION OF THE SOMERSET CITY COUNCIL IN SUPPORT OF THE LAKE CUMBERLAND AREA DRUG TASK FORCE.

WHEREAS, THE LAKE CUMBERLAND AREA DRUG TASK FORCE WAS FORMED TO PROVIDE DRUG BROOKEMENT ACTIVITIES IN CONJUNCTION WITH OTHER AGENCIES AND HAS HADD NON-INTERRUPTED SERVICE TO THE CITIZENS OF SOMERSET, AND THE SURROUNDING COMMUNITIES, SINCE 1993; AND

WHEREAS, IN THE LAST FIVE YEARS THE DRUG TASK FORCE HAS EFFECTED 771
ARRESTS, TAKEN \$16.5 MILLION DOLLARS IN DRUGS OF THE STREET AND SEIZED OVER
\$1.7 IN CASH AND PROPERTY FROM DRUG DEALERS AND DRUG TRAFFICKING
ORGANIZATIONS; AND

WHEREAS, THE CITY OF SOMERSET AND THE SOMERSET POLICE DEPARTMENT HAVE ALWAYS HAD A MUTUALLY PRODUCTIVE WORKING RELATIONSHIP WITH THE LAKE CUMBERLAND AREA DRUG TASK FORCE; AND

WHEREAS, THE SOMERSET CITY COUNCIL VOTED TO AMEND THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE DRUG TASK FORCE ON AUGUST 25, 2003; AND

WHEREAS, ACTIONS TAKEN RECENTLY HAVE THREATENED THE OPERATION OF THE DRUG TASK FORCE AND ENDANGERED THE LIVELIHOODS OF THE AGENTS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE DRUG TASK FORCE;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY HEREBY ADOPT THIS RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE LAKE CUMBERLAND AREA DRUG TASK FORCE AND TO VOICE OUR RESOLVE IN THE CONTINUED FIGHT IN THE WAR ON DRUGS IN SOMERSET AND THE SURROUNDING AREA.

FURTHERMORE, THIS COUNCIL WILL STRIVE TO DO EVERYTHING POSSIBLE THROUGH LEGISLATIVE ACTION TO REMAIN THE GRANT FUNDING AUTHORITY AND TO CONTINUI OUR RELATIONSHIP WITH THE LAKE CUMBERLAND AREA DRUG TASK FORCE. THE COUNCIL ALSO REQUESTS THAT THE DRUG TASK FORCE BE GIVEN THE FULL 60 DAY
