ORDINANCE NO	TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the appurtenances, thereunto belonging, unto the Second Party, its successors and assigns, forever, with covenant of GENERAL WARRANTY. II. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after adoption. FIRST READING
I. By changing a boundary of land being zoned R-2 to land being zoned R-3, more particularly described as follows: A certain tract or parcel of land located on the south east side of Monticello Street in Pulaski County, Kentucky, approximately 0.1 mile from the junction of Langdon Street and Monticello Street. BEING THE SAME PROPERTY conveyed to Stewart Development, Inc., a Kentucky corporation, by Deed of Conveyance dated the 27° of August, 2004, from Marvin Coomer and Barbara Coomer, husband and wife, of Record in Deed Book 744, page 443, Pulaski County (Errk's Office, Kentucky. All corners or witness monuments referred to herein as iron pins set are marked one-half inch rebar 18 inches long and capped with an orange cap marked LS 1253, except as otherwise noted.
