
Subject: Concrete and Blacktop Bids

We only received one bid for blacktop this year. Hinkle Contracting had a bid of \$69,00/ton for base and surface F.O.B. and \$75.95/ton applied. There is a \$15.00/ton surcharge for orders of F.O.B mix less than 100 tons during non-producing hours and any applied asphalt orders less than 150 tons.


We received three bids for concrete this year. Tucker Readymix had the lowest bid at \$94.79/yd for Class A and \$92.79/yd for Class B. Readymix Concrete had a bid of \$98.00/yd for Class A and \$95.50/yd for Class B. Pyles Concrete had a bid of \$98.00/yd for both Class A and Class B. I recommend awarding the concrete bid to Tucker Readymix and that we use Readymix Concrete and Pyles Concrete as backups if Tuckers cannot deliver as needed.
