MINUTES OF MEETING HELD JUNE 23, 2014

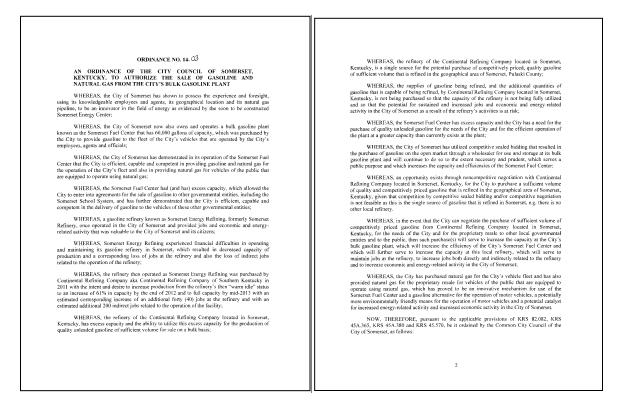
