
MINUTES OF MEETING HELD MARCH 24, 2014


The Common Council of the City of Somerset, Kentucky met in a regular meeting on Monday March 24, 2014, at 7:00 p.m. with the following present: Mayor Eddie Girdler. Council Members; Jimmy Eastham, Jerry Girdler, Mike New, Donna Hunley, John Minton, Pat Bourne, Jerry Burnett, Tom Eastham, Jim Rutherford, and Linda Stringer. Mr. Rutherford moved to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held on March 10, 2014 along with reports as mailed. Mr. New seconded the motion.
