BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY, That the Chief of the Somerset Fire Department be and is hereby authorized to apply for and, if awarded, accept the FY 2018 Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (SAFER) grant which is funded through the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMAL), in the approximate amount of \$445,000. The funds will be uved to fund staffing for four (4) fireflighters.
