MUNICIPAL ROAD AID COOPERATIVE PROGRAM AGREEMENT

of the Transportation Cabinet, is made by and between the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Transportation Cabinet, Department of Bural and Municipal Aid ("the Department"), and the Legislative Body of the incorporated City of SQUERSET. Kentucky (the "City").

WHICKERS, Kentucky Remed Statutes (KRS) § 177-365(1) prevides that 7.7% of revenue resulting from the imposition of motor fuel taxes on taxpayers pursuant to XRS § Administration Cabinet for the construction, reconstruction, and maintenance of urban roads and streets, and for no other purpose ("Numcipal Road Av6 funds"), and

pirticipate in a cooperative program to aid the City in the construction, reconstruction, and maintenance of certain roads and bridges using its share of the Municipal Road Aid Funds

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms and conditions contained herein and acknowledged, the Department and the City agree as follows:

3 Apportionment of Municipal Road Aid Funds. The City's apportionment of Municipal Road Aid Funds shall be based on revenue estimates supplied by the Office of State Budget Director. For the Fiscal Year bedraning July 1, 2020, this amount is \$203,512,69
