A MUNICIPAL ORDER OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY, AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A 2017 KENTLICKY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PUBLIC SERVICES APPLICATION;

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the public interest that the City avail itself of the financial assistance provided by Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, and the 1981 Amendments pertainting the Kentecks Department for Lucal Coverhanced, Division of Community Development, to commonce a Community Development Program within the community; and

WHEREAS, it is recognized that the Federal State contract for such ficated assistance present to said. Tale 1 will impose certain obligations and responsibilities upon the City and will require awang other thiege.

- Approval of a satisfactory application transmitted to the Kentucky Department for Local Government, Office of Federal Grants;
- Certification by the City Council relating to activities such as civil rights, eithern participation, relocation payments, acquisition of properties, national environmental policies, and accounting practices; and,
- Other local obligations and responsibilities in connection with the undertaking and carrying out of the Kentucky Community Development Block Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, in these areas where acquisition and clearance is propused, the objectives of the program cannot be achieved through more extensive rehabilitation, and a displacement strategy has been formulated;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the common council of the City of Somerset

WHEREAS, ORDINANCE 536 HAS BEEN AMENDED TO ALLOW CHANGES TO FEES AND CHARGES FOR ALL. OTHER ASPECTS OF SEWER SERVICE, SPECIFICALLY IN ORDINANCES 85-8, 87-11, 91-20, 84-9, 00-04, 00-07, AND 00-13. AS WELL AS UPDATED ANNUAL RATE SCHEDULES ADOPTED WITH THE CITY'S ANNUAL BUDGET ORDINANCES: AND

WHEREAS, OTHER TYPES OF FEFSIRATES HAVE BEEN ADJUSTED OVER THE DECADES FOR THE SANIARY SEWER SYSTEM, FEES AND CLIARGIS FOR INITIAL TAPPINGCONNECTION FEES FOR SEWER SERVICE HAVE NOT BEEN UPDATED OR AMENDED SINCE SAID FEES WERE SET IN ORDINANCE 586. SEPCIFICALLY SECTION 3, WHICH WAS ORIGINALLY ENACTED IN MAY 1976, AND

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOMERSE I. KENTUCKY:

Industrial Facility

\$.10 per sq fl. with a minimum charge of \$1.000.00**

- (IV) This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage, approval, and publication according to law. The new rates adopted in this Ordinance shall be applied beginning July 1, 2017.

WHEREAS, ORDINANCE 01-15 HAS BEEN AMENDED TO ALLOW CHANGES TO FEES AND CHARGES FOR ALL OTHER ASPECTS OF WATER SERVICE, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, ORDINANCE 10-03. AS WELL AS CYPOATED ANNUAL RATE SCHEDULES ADDITED WITH THE CITY'S ANNUAL BUDGET ORDINANCES; AND

WHEREAS, OTHER TYPES OF FYESTRATES HAVE BEEN ADJUSTED OVER THE DECADES FOR THE WATER SYSTEM, FEES AND CHARGES FOR INITIAL TAP ON FEES FOR WATER SERVICE HAVE NOT BEEN UPDATED OR AMENDED SINCE THE BRACTIMENT OF ORDINANCE OF 11.5 SPECIFICALLY SECTION 3 (D), WHICH WAS ORIGINALLY FINAL PLACTED IN JUNE 2001; AND

WHEREAS, THE CITY HAS DETERMINED THAT SAID SERVICES CAN NO LONGER BE PROVIDED FOR THE RATES SET IN ORDINANCE 01-15, SECTION AUD, AND THEREFORE WISHES TO AMEDD SAID RATES PURSUANT TO KRS CHAPTER 91A, AND ALL OTHER APPLICABLE LAW; AND

WHEREAS, THE CITY HAS ALSO DETERMIND THAT THE CHARGES FOR OTHER TYPES OF CONNECTIONS TO THE CITY'S WALLER SYSTEM AS SET FORTH IN ORDINANCE 10-03, SPECIFICALLY SECTION 5(A), SUBSECTIONS (A) AND (B). NEED TO BE ADJUSTED AND THEREFORE WISHES TO AMERICAN TO KRS CHAPTER 91A, AND ALL OTHER APPLICABLE LAW;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY:

Ordinance 01-15, Section 3D, adopted on June 11, 2001, is bereby repealed and replaced in full with the following:

Effective July 1, 2017, a schedule of top on fees for each tap on to the Water System of the City of Someract, Kentucky is hereby established, and from and after said date, payment pursuant to said schedule of tap on fees shall be paid to the City within intext (90) days of onlice given to the owner or occupant of any permisses where water service is made available by the City. Said notice shall include a statement that the adjacent water facility is capable of providing service to the meters of in the volume and manner requested. Said notice shall also include a statement that the City of Somerset, and/or any other governmental agency

required to approve said tap on, has approved, or has been provided written confirmation of any such needed approval(s). Said schedule of tap on fees is set as follows:

Fee will be determined by the City of Somerset's Water Department, and shall be based on factors including, but not limited to, the size, the focusion and the estimated cost(s). At no time shall the fee less than the actual cost(s) incurred by the City of Somerset.**

"This schedule is intended to cover any and all up on connections that we considered new to the City's Nater System as determined by the City of Sumerses, and shall not apply to "connect or re-connects" as defined by the City and as unsended below.

** This fee may be adjusted by the l'ity of Somerset for industrial and manufacturing developments in order to promote the growth of Economic Development, so long as the top on fee charged is not less than the actual cost(v) incurred by the City of Sonterest.

(II) Ordinance 10-03, Section 3B, Subsections (a) and (b), adopted on April 12, 2010, is bereby repealed and replaced in full with the following:

B. Connect Fees:

(a) Effective July 1, 2017, a schedule of non-refundable connect fees* for the Water System of the City of Somerset. Kentucky is hereby established. Said schedule of non-refundable connect fees shall apply regardless of whether the location is inside, or outside, the City's corporate limits. The schedule of non-refundable connect fees is set as follows.
