Mr. Wheeldon moved to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held on July 24, 2017 along with reports as mailed. Mr. New seconded the motion. ## THIS ORDENANCE NUMBER 17. $\frac{1.5}{10}$ FIXING THE TAX LEVY, AD VALOREM, FRANCHISE TAX, AND TAX FOR THE CITY OF SOMEBSET, KENTUCKY, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BECOMNIG JULY 1, 2017 AND ENDING JULE 38, 2018 FROVIDING FENALTY AND INTEREST FOR NON-PAYMENT. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY.

SECTION 1. That for the purpose of providing memory for general municipal expenses for the City of Semarene, Kentucky, for the fixed year beginning July 1, 2017 and ending June 30, 2018 in hereby levels and a valarene of hittenen center (130) on each handred dollars (\$100.00) of taxable property within the city limits of Somerset, Kentucky.

SECTION 2. That the thirteen cents (130) ad valorem on each one hundred dollars (3100.00) of taxeble property which the tity limits of Somerset. Kentacky, levied shall be deposited in the general find account and shall be used to pay on general expenses invidental to the operation of the city government.

SECTION 3. That for the purpose of providing income for general municipal expenses for the City of Somerset, Kentucky for the fixeal year beginning July 7, 2017 and ending Jame 30, 2018 there is hereby leviced a tax of thirteen cents (130) on each hundred dollars (\$100.00) on personal property, inarphile and intangible of functhics holders as determined by the Department of Revenue within the city limits of Somerset, Kentucky.

SECTION 4. The thirteen cents (.130) on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for financhics property within the city limits of Sounerset. Kentucky, shall be deposited in the general fund account and is to be used to pay on expenses incidental to the operation of city government.

SECTION 5. That a two peterst (2%) discount shall be allowed on each one dollar (\$1.00) collected before November 1, 2017.

SECTION 6. That there shall be added to and collected a penalty of twenty percent (20%) and interest of aix percent (6%) per annum upon each one dollar (\$1.00) of all taxes herein provided for and unpaid after January 1, 2018 until such time that suid taxes are paid.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance is to become in full force and effect on and after its approval and passage according to law.

## ORDINANCE NO. 17-14

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A BANK FRANCHISE AND LOCAL DEPOSIT TAX: SETTING FORTH TIME TABLES FOR THE COLLECTION OF SUCH TAX FOR THE VEAR BIT AND ALL SUBSEQUENT VEARS, AND SETTING FORTH ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURES, INCLUDING PENALTIES FOR THE COLLECTION OF DELINOVENT TAXES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET, RENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: There is hereby imposed on all "financial institutions" as defined in KRS Chapter 136, located within the corporate limits of the City of Somerset, Kentucky, for the 2017 tay year and the subsequent years, a finetachis texa at the start of 0.023% on all deposite, as defined in KRS Chapter 136, maintained by such financial institutions.

SECTION 2: The City of Somerset, Kenucky will issue tax bills to financial institutions no later than December 1 of each year. Payment of the tax shall be the with a two parcent (2%) discount by December 31 of each year, or without discount by January 31 of each year.

SECTION 3: The City of Somernet, Kentucky, shall have a lien for taxes on the property assessed for taxes to the extent allowed under KRS 134-420.

SECTION 4: All taxes due in accordance with these accions which are not paid before June 30, 2018 for the tax year 2017, or which are not paid before January 31, for all subsequent tax years shall be deemed delinquent and shall be subject to a penalty of 20% and shall bear interest at the net of 6% per anum.

SECTION 5: All moneys collected pursuant to these sections shall be paid into the General Fund of the City to be used for the payment of proper expenditures as determined by the City Council.

SECTION 6: The City Clerk is hereby directed to send a copy of their Ordinance to the Commissioner of the Kennicky Department of Revenue, Frankfart, Kentucky.
