## MUNICIPAL ORDER

A MUNICIPAL ORDER, ENACTED IN ACCORDANCE TO KRS 83A 060, AND PURSUANT TO KRS 81A 427, SETTING FORTH THE OBJECTIONS OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET, BY AND THROUGH THE CITY COUNCIL, REGARDING THE CITY OF DURNSIDE'S INTENT AND DESIRE TO ANNEX A PORTION OF A CORRIDOR OF HIGHWAY BELONGING TO THE KENTUCKY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (KYDOT) KNOWN AS HWY, 2301, AND LOCATED IN PULASKI COUNTY, KENTUCKY;

WHEREAS, pursuant to KRS 81A.427, the City of Somerset has the right to object and prevent annexation by enacting a municipal order according to KRS 83A.060; and

WHEREAS, the City of Somerset owns utility infrastructure as defined in KRS 81A.427(1), and that said infrastructure is located within all, or part, of the area which the City of Burnside has indicated and/or proposed that it intends to annex; and

WHEREAS, the City of Somerset herein incorporates by reference in full all attachments marked in its entirety as Exhibit "A", including but not limited to maps and/or drawings, attached hereto as permitted under KRS 81A.427(5), and describing in detail the referred to infrastructure owned by the City of Somerset so that said infrastructure is clearly identified within the subject area;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY:

That the City of Somerset, Kentucky does hereby object for the purpose of preventing annexation of property containing infrastructure utilities owned by the City of Somerset, as well as to fulfill the requirements of KRS 81A.427, to the City of Burnside's intent and proposal to annex to the City of Burnside the area as set forth and shown in Exhibit "B", attached hereto and incorporated in full herein, which was provided to the City of Somerset by the City of Burnside.

This Municipal Order was enacted by vote of the Somerset City Council on the Le day of Yhumles 2012.
