AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 00-18, KNOWN AS THE ZONING ORDINANCE AND ALTERING THE ZONING MAP, BY CHANGING A BOUNDARY OF LAND NOW ZONED R-2 TO B-3. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY
