RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Somerset proposes to provide upgraded drinking water service for industrial, institutional, commercial, and residential growth in the Oak Hill and Valley Oak areas, and

WHEREAS, the City of Somerset endorses said proposed service, and.

WHEREAS, under the terms of the Safe Drinking Water Act Amendments of 1996 (Public Law 104-182) and amendments to KRS 224A, the State is authorized to render financial assistance to eligible project applicants by way of capitalization grants from the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency and State match funds comprising the Federally Assisted Drinking Water Revolving Fund (State Revolving Loan Program). The program is established to aid in the construction of drinking water treatment facilities improvements and certain related facilities with consideration for approval to be based on applications submitted through the Kentucky Energy and Environment Cabinet and the Kentucky Infrastructure Authority, and,

WHEREAS, the improvements proposed for construction by the City of Somerset within the WX21199002 WRIS project profile are considered eligible for such loan assistance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Somerset that the Mayor Alan Keck, and Successors-in-Title are hereby authorized to execute and submit an application through the Kentucky Energy and Environment Cabinet and the Kentucky Infrastructure Authority with such assurances and required supporting data as is necessary to obtain loan assistance from the Federally Assisted Drinking Water Revolving Fund (State Revolving Loan Program) for the proposed water treatment facilities improvements, and are hereby authorized as City of Somerset's Official Project Representative to carry out necessary negotiations for and administer the loan assistance the applicant may obtain from the Federally Assisted Drinking Water Revolving Fund (State Revolving Loan Program).
