

MINUTES OF MEETING HELD SEPTEMBER 8, 2008

The Common Council of the City of Somerset, Kentucky met in a regular session on Monday September 8, 2008 at 7:00 p.m. with the following present: Mayor Eddie Girdler. Council Members: Jim Mitchell, Pat Bourne, Jerry Burnett, Tim Rutherford, Jim Rutherford, Linda Stringer, James Eastham, Steve Kelley, Jerry Girdler, David Childers, Donna Hunley, and John Minton. City Attorney Carrie Wiese and City Clerk David Godsey.

Mr. Bourne moved to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting held on August 25, 2008, along with the reports to be approved as mailed. Mr. J. Rutherford seconded the motion. Upon roll call the following Council Members voted “Aye”: Mr. Mitchell, Mr. Bourne, Mr. Burnett, Mr. T. Rutherford, Mr. J. Rutherford, Mrs. Stringer, Mr. Eastham, Mr. Kelley, Mr. Girdler, Mr. Childers, Mrs. Hunley, and Mr. Minton.

Mr. Eastham moved to approve the request of the Pulaski County Extension Office and UK College of Agriculture’s Cooperative Extension Services to close a portion of downtown Sunday, October 12th, 2pm to 5pm for a fitness parade to encourage the community to get out, get moving and have a healthy lifestyle. Mr. Childers seconded the motion. Upon roll call the following Council Members voted “Aye”: Mr. Mitchell, Mr. Bourne, Mr. Burnett, Mr. T. Rutherford, Mr. J. Second reading was given the following Ordinance No. # 08-13:

ORDINANCE NO. 08-13

THIS ORDINANCE NUMBER 08-13 FIXING THE TAX LEVY, AD VALOREM, FRANCHISE TAX, AND TAX FOR THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2008 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2009 PROVIDING PENALTY AND INTEREST FOR NON-PAYMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY:

SECTION 1. That for the purpose of providing income for general municipal expenses for the City of Somerset, Kentucky, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2008 and ending June 30, 2009 is hereby levied an ad valorem of eighteen point five cents (.185) on each hundred dollars (\$100.00) of taxable property within the city limits of Somerset, Kentucky.

SECTION 2. That the eighteen point five cents (.185) ad valorem on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of taxable property within the city limits of Somerset, Kentucky, levied shall be deposited in the general fund account and shall be used to pay on general expenses incidental to the operation of the city government.

SECTION 3. That for the purpose of providing income for general municipal expenses for the City of Somerset, Kentucky for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2008 and ending June 30, 2009 there is hereby levied a tax of eighteen point five cents (.185) on each hundred dollars (\$100.00) on personal property, tangible and intangible of franchise holders as determined by the Department of Revenue within the city limits of Somerset, Kentucky.

SECTION 4. The eighteen point five cents (.185) on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for franchise property within the city limits of Somerset, Kentucky, shall be deposited in the general fund account and is to be used to pay on expenses incidental to the operation of city government.

SECTION 5. That a one percent (.01%) discount shall be allowed on each one dollar (\$1.00) collected before November 1, 2008.

SECTION 6. That there shall be added to and collected a penalty of twenty percent (.20%) and interest of six percent (.06%) per annum upon each one dollar (\$1.00) of all taxes herein provided for and unpaid after January 1, 2009 until such time that said taxes are paid.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance is to become in full force and effect on and after its approval and passage according to law.

Second reading was given the following Ordinance # 08-14:

ORDINANCE NO. 08-14	
AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A BANK FRANCHISE AND LOCAL DEPOSIT TAX: SETTING FORTH TIME TABLES FOR THE COLLECTION OF SUCH TAX FOR THE YEAR 2008 AND ALL SUBSEQUENT YEARS; AND SETTING FORTH ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURES, INCLUDING PENALTIES FOR THE COLLECTION OF DELINQUENT TAXES.	
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:	
SECTION 1: There is hereby imposed on all “financial institutions” as defined in KRS Chapter 136, located within the corporate limits of the City of Somerset, Kentucky, for the 2008 tax year and all subsequent years, a franchise tax at the rate of 0.025% on all deposits, as defined in KRS Chapter 136, maintained by such financial institutions.	
SECTION 2: The City of Somerset, Kentucky will issue tax bills to financial institutions no later than December 1 of each year. Payment of the tax shall be due with a two percent (.2%) discount by December 31 of each year, or without discount by January 31 of each year.	
SECTION 3: The City of Somerset, Kentucky, shall have a lien for taxes on the property assessed for taxes to the extent allowed under KRS 134-420.	
SECTION 4: All taxes due in accordance with these sections which are not paid before June 30, 2009 for the tax year 2008, or which are not paid before January 31, for all subsequent tax years shall be deemed delinquent and shall be subject to a penalty of .20% and shall bear interest at the rate of .6% per annum.	
SECTION 5: All moneys collected pursuant to these sections shall be paid into the General Fund of the City to be used for the payment of proper expenditures as determined by the City Council.	
SECTION 6: The City Clerk is hereby directed to send a copy of their Ordinance to the Commissioner of the Kentucky Department of Revenue, Frankfort, Kentucky.

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY, TO DEDICATE THE ROADWAY COMMONLY AND LEGALLY KNOWN AS "UNIVERSITY DRIVE" IN HONOR OF JOSH ANDERSON, SAID ROADWAY BEING LOCATED WITHIN THE INCORPORATED BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET;

WHEREAS, the City of Somerset, Kentucky, by and through the City Council, wishes to honor Josh Anderson, a Pulaski County native, for his great athletic achievements and accomplishments in the sport of Baseball; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby wishes to dedicate the roadway commonly and legally known as "University Drive" to Josh Anderson, said roadway running East to West from North Main Street to Kentucky State Highway 39, said portion of roadway being located within the corporate boundaries of the City of Somerset;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved and ordained by the Common Council of the City of Somerset, Kentucky this ____ day of _____, 2008, that:

I.

That the City hereby dedicates a portion of University Drive as described above to Josh Anderson so that said roadway will be hereafter known as "Josh Anderson Drive"; and

II.

That said dedication is to be in the form of signage properly located along said roadway, in accordance with state highway department regulations and all other applicable law; and

III.

That the Council wishes to hold a ceremony where said roadway will be officially dedicated to Josh Anderson so that his family and the community can share in the event, with said event to be set at a later date by the City Council; and

IV.

That this resolution shall be in full force and effect upon passage by the common council and according to law.
