## BOND ORDINANCE NO. 14-09 - ENERGY CENTER PROJECT

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY AUTHORIZING AND PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF \$9,350,000 PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF CITY OF SOMERSET GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS (ENERGY CENTER PROJECT), SERIES 2015, CONSISTING OF \$8,500,000 OF SERIES A BONDS AND \$950,000 OF SERIES B BONDS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING THE COST (NOT OTHERWISE PROVIDED)OF THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN ENERGY CENTER FOR SAID CITY; SETTING FORTH TERMS AND CONDITIONS UPON WHICH SAID BONDS MAY BE ISSUED AND OUTSTANDING; PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION, SEGREGATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF THE TAX REVENUES OF SAID CITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN ADVERTISED, PUBLIC COMPETITIVE SALE OF SAID BONDS.

MUNICIPAL ORDER OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY, ACCEPTING THE SUCCESSFUL BID FOR THE PURCHASE OF \$9,36,900 FRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF CITY OF SOMERSET GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS (ENERGY CENTER PROJECT), SERIES 2015.

WHEREAS, Notice of Sale of \$9,350,000 of City of Somerset General Obligation Bonds (Energy Center Project), Serice 2015, consisting of \$8,500,000 of Serice & Bonds and \$\$\$50,000 of Serice B Bonds (collectively, the "Bonds") has heretofore been given in strict compliance with the proceedings of this City Council of the City of Somerset (the "City") and with the provisions of the publication laws applicable thereto, thus enabling everyone interested in said Bonds to present a romocal in comerction therewith has the control of the City of Somerset and Something S

WHEREAS, the only bid received for the purchase of and Bonds was the bid of the U.S. Deputment of Agriculture, acting through Rural Housing service (PREF), which bid was a bid of par for all of the Bonds at an interest rate not to exceed 5.50% per anums as to the Series A Bonds and 4.00% per anums as to the Series B Bonds, subject to the right of the City to request that such Bonds and shall bear interest at anch lower interest rate as may be in effect for REIS tomat the time of delivery of

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable that the City Council adopt a Municipal Order accepting

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. <u>SECTION 2.</u> That the interest rate on said Bonds is hereby fixed at 3.50% per annum as to the Series A Bonds and 4.00% per annum as to the Series B Bonds (or at such lower interest rate as may be ambigable as a foresaid as set out in such bid

SECTION 3. That in accordance with the terms of the commitment of RHS, approved by the City and RHS, and as provided in the Official Notice of Sale of Bonds, said Bonds shall be issued to RHS as a Series A Bond and a Series B Bond both in fully registered form SECTION 4. That said Bonds shall be delivered by the City Trassource and/or other proper City officials to RHS as soon as said Bonds are printed and ready for delivery in accordance with the Bond Ordinance, and that all of the proceeds of the sale of said Bonds shall be used only as movided in the Bond Ordinance.
