Separate sealed BIDS for the construction of Water System Improvements for the City of Somerset, Kentucky will be received at 306 E. Mt. Vernon Road, Somerset, Kentucky 42501 until 2:00 p.m. Eastern Time, Wednesday, March 25, 2020, and then at said time and place will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids being mailed should be addressed to Nick Bradley, City of Somerset, P. O. Box 989, Somerset, Kentucky 42502 and the bidder shall be responsible for timely delivery.

The work involved is in one (1) contract and consists of the following generally described work:

CONTRACT 19-01
16-INCH INTERCONNECT WATER LINE

- 375 L.F. of 16-inch DIP Water Line installed by Open-Cut Methods
- 195 L.F. of 16-inch RJDIP Water Line installed in 24-inch Steel Casing Pipe
- 185 L.F. of 24-inch Steel Casing Pipe bored under U.S. Highway 27
- Two Lump Sum connections to existing 16-inch water lines

The allotted time for construction of Contract 19-01 is 90 calendar days; liquidated damages for non-completion are \$1,000 per calendar day.

Local resident bidders may be eligible for a Kentucky resident bidders preference pursuant to KRS 45A.

The successful bidder or bidders shall be required to furnish both an acceptable performance bond and payment bond each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price.

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The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive informalities, and to negotiate with the apparent qualified best bidder or bidders to such extent as may be necessary.

No bidder may withdraw his bid for 90 days, while the Owner considers the bids. Mutually agreed upon time extensions may be made if necessary.

Pursuant to KRS 45A.494, a resident bidder of the Commonwealth shall be given a preference against a nonresident bidder registered in any state that gives or requires a preference to bidders from that state. The preference shall be equal to the preference given or required by the state of the nonresident bidder.
