RE: 2008-2009 BUDGET

Council Members:

I have met with Skip and Jim and we have separated the budgets for Fire and EMS. Here are the highlights of the amendment:

The General fund will not change in total. The money budgeted to be transferred to EMS will be adjusted in line items to cover the Fire Department Expenses for the remainder of the fiscal year. This amounts to \$895,837.50 plus the amount of the Assistance to Firefighters grant and its match money.

The EMS budget will decrease by \$1,645,291.20 on both revenue and expenses. This is due to lost contribution from the City, the grant, and some adjustments to revenue projections for collections from runs.

EMS employees will change back to a 40 hour schedule effective March 1, 2009. Their hourly rates will be adjusted to include the \$3100 and everyone's annual pay will remain as it was.

The "split" will be effective 2/1/09 as far as the accounting and payroll functions.
