A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY ACKNOWLEDGING STRONG SUPPORT FOR THE SUBMISSION OF A FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION GRANT BY THE KENTUCKY TRANSPORTATION CABINET FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO KENTUCKY HIGHWAY 80, KENTUCKY HIGHWAY 461, AND POTENTIALLY I-69 INTERSECTION OF SAID MAJOR HIGHWAYS.

WHEREAS, the City of Somerset has significant economic and infrastructure needs resulting from the continuing and major growth and development in the improvement of KY 461, KY80, and I-60 including four lane of KY 461; and

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Kentucky, with support of Senator Rick Girdler, Representative Tommy Turner, and area state legislators allocated over \$22 million of state funds for the project; and
