

MINUTES OF MEETING HELD JUNE 24, 2019

The Common Council of the City of Somerset, Kentucky met in a regular meeting on Monday June 24, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. with the following present: Council Members; David Burdine, Brian Dalton, Jerry Wheeldon, Jimmy Eastham, Jerry Girdler, Mike New, Donna Hunley, John Minton, Jim Mitchell, David Godsey, Amanda Bullock, Mayor Alan Keck, City Attorney John Adams, and City Clerk Nick Bradley. Absent; Council Members Tom Eastham.

Mr. Mitchell moved to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held on June 10, 2019 along with reports as mailed. Mr. Dalton seconded the motion. First reading was given the following Ordinance Number 19-15: Establishing an Entertainment Destination Center in the Downtown Area of Somerset, Kentucky; Further Directing the Application for an Entertainment Destination Center License from the Kentucky Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control; and Further Establishing the Requirements for a Licensee to Sell Alcoholic Beverages within the Common Areas of the Entertainment Destination Center.

ORDINANCE 19-15

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AN ENTERTAINMENT DESTINATION CENTER IN THE DOWNTOWN AREA OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY; FURTHER DIRECTING THE APPLICATION FOR AN ENTERTAINMENT DESTINATION CENTER LICENSE FROM THE KENTUCKY DEPARTMENT OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL; AND FURTHER ESTABLISHING THE REQUIREMENTS FOR A LICENSEE TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE COMMON AREAS OF THE ENTERTAINMENT DESTINATION CENTER.

SECTION 1. Authority for issuance of an Entertainment Destination Center License shall be: Kentucky Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control.

SECTION 2. It is the intent of this Ordinance to establish the Entertainment Destination Center in the Downtown Area of Somerset, Kentucky, as shown on the attached map.

SECTION 3. It is further intended that the requirements for a license to sell alcoholic beverages within the common areas of the Entertainment Destination Center shall be as follows:

SECTION 4. The provisions of the Entertainment Destination Center License shall be as follows:

(1) The applicant for an Entertainment Destination Center License shall be the City of Somerset, Kentucky. The City of Somerset shall apply for an Entertainment Destination Center License from the Kentucky Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control.

(2) The applicant shall file an application for an Entertainment Destination Center License with the Kentucky Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control. The application shall include the following information:

- (a) A description of the proposed Entertainment Destination Center, including the location, size, and layout of the building and the grounds around the building.
- (b) A description of the proposed Entertainment Destination Center, including the location, size, and layout of the building and the grounds around the building.

(3) When a permit is issued by the Kentucky Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control, the applicant shall be required to comply with all applicable regulations and rules of the Kentucky Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control. If the applicant is not in compliance with these requirements, the permit shall be suspended or revoked.

(4) Any person who violates the terms of a permit issued by the Kentucky Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control shall be subject to the penalties provided in the Kentucky Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control regulations and rules.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2019 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2020, ESTIMATING REVENUES AND EXPENSES AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS AN ANNUAL BUDGET HAS BEEN ADOPTED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOMERSET, KENTUCKY; AND

WHEREAS THE COMMON COUNCIL HAS REVIEWED PROPOSED BUDGET EXCHANGES AND HAS MADE NECESSARY BUDGET ADJUSTS;
