Whereas the residential street Teresa Avenue is in the former "Haney Farm" area of the City of Somerset (annexed by the City of Somerset by Ordinance 494 in May of 1973) and a mapping overlap with the City of Ferguson was found in December 2021,

Whereas the City of Somerset Council passed Resolution 22-04 regarding the matter,

Whereas the City of Ferguson passed a recent Resolution disclaiming the Haney Farm area,

Whereas the Kentucky Secretary of State has sent an email April 8, 2022, recognizing the Resolutions and indicating the overlap will be solved;

Now Therefore, be it RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Somerset hereby states:

The City of Somerset recognizes and adopts for the purposes of record retention the plat titled "City of Ferguson Resolution to Resolve Mapping Error / Somerset Ordinance 494" and is attached as Exhibit A hereto.

The City of Somerset acknowledges the April 8<sup>th</sup>, 2022 email from Ms. Kandie Adkinson of the Secretary of State Land Section to Ferguson City Attorney Carrie Wiese and others indicating the overlap has been resolved and the action being taken by her office (see Exhibit B).

The City of Somerset express its appreciation to the City of Ferguson for resolving the matter.


